### Social skills: CONFLICT MASTER

# **Number of players**

The game is suitable for 2 to 8 players.

#### Game content

Game board, 1 die, 8 counters, 5 categories with 21 cards per category.

## **Introduction**

This is a board game about conflict. Some questions may be difficult, other questions may be easier. The idea is that everyone can freely say what he/she thinks without others commenting on it. If you want to say something, you can raise your hand and wait until it is your turn. Everyone is expected to respond appropriately and respectfully. Always think first about what you are going to say and whether it is appropriate or inappropriate.

# Goal of the game

Try to collect 5 cards in 5 different colors as quickly as possible. If you have the tickets, rush to 'CONFLICT MASTER'. With your tickets in hand, you can enter immediately. If you manage to reach 'CONFLICT MASTER' first, then you are the conflict master of the day! But be careful, because you can still lose a ticket along the way. And then you have to look for a new one again.

## Start of the game

- Choose a pawn and place it on one of the starting spaces.
- Then take turns rolling the dice to determine who starts the game: the player who rolls the highest number of points starts. Afterwards, play takes place in a clockwise direction.

## Game flow

- After rolling the die, move your pawn in any direction. You may move forward as many spaces as
  the die indicates. Please note, you are not allowed to move forward and backward during the same
  turn.
- If your pawn lands on a colored space, you can take a card in the correct color and read it out loud and answer the question.
  - o Orange: What are you doing?
  - o Blue: Role play: What happens next?
  - o Green: Conflict questiono Purple: Complete sentence
  - o Yelllow: Do-assignment
- If the answer is correct, you get the card. If the answer is wrong, you must put the card back at the bottom of the pile. Please note: if you already have a card of that color, you must return it to the bottom of the correct pile if you answer incorrectly.

## **Special compartments**

- Stop: Skip 1 turn.
- Die: throw again and continue in the same direction.
- Crook: drop off 1 ticket of your choice.
- Empty box: nothing happens, the turn passes to the next player.

#### End

The game ends when one player has reached 'CONFLICT MASTER' with those 5 cards in the 5 different colors. To reach the end goal, you MUST roll the exact number of spots.
