They can do this by following the students' progress in the pathway (this isn't built into the tool so they can do this by noting the progress within a session) or by the conversations they have about the subjects (does the student understand what they are learning and how to apply it to their life?). The students rate the pathways after working with it. They can tell how relevant they thought the information was for them, if they missed information, etc. by scaling it between 1 (not helpful) to 5 (very helpful).
