The Multiplier Event took place in Skopje. The event was dedicated to our project SocVoc. The majority of the participants were professionals that study or work in the field of penitentiary system or have interest in prison education.

The project team from the Faculty of Security-Skopje (University “St. Kliment Ohridski”- Bitola) for the SocVoc project in North Macedonia, shared the main priorities of the SocVoc project and introduced the project results that can be used by the professionals that work in the prison system or provide different kinds of educational course in prisons in Macedonia. In the first part of the event, the project coordinator for SocVoc project in North Macedonia prof. Vesna Stefanovska, had presentation for the focus of the SocVoc project and the importance of the improving adult learners’ social skills during vocational training in prison. In the second part, project assistant prof. Natasha Peovska introduced the created web site for the project ([www.socvoc.eu](http://www.socvoc.eu)) and the project results regarding: best practices for improving social skills during vocational training in prisons, games and exercises that can be used for self-learning of the adult learners, methodological recommendations for adults learners in prison and guidelines for teachers in prison (class management in vocational education with a focus on social

skills). The presentation of the gathered and prepared materials in the SocVoc project, was followed by fruitful group discussion in which participants actively engage in sharing their own knowledge, experience and the possibility of implementing the prepared materials from the SocVoc project in their work.

The multiplier event was attended by 46 people who worked in various forms of prison education: teachers, vocational trainers, prison staff, social workers, psychologists and students. The participants were satisfied with the organization of the event, the provided information and the opportunity to use online all the useful materials for enhancing the social skills of adult learners during vocational training in prisons.
